

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How to find Budemeadows

These directions are mainly for those coming from the North via the M5 or the East/SouthEast using the A303 or M4/M5.

Note for Sat-Nav Users. Your Sat-Nav will probably try to take you to the middle of the postcode area and will tell you to turn off the A39 towards Widemouth Bay (Leverlake Road). If you are coming South then when it does this we are 200 metres further on to the left, if you're driving North then you've gone 200 metres too far. We recommend the 3rd of these routes, particularly if towing.

The easy route:



Straightforward but there are several sharp bends between the Clovelly roundabout and Kilkhampton on the A39. Exit the M5 at junction 27 (signed Barnstaple). Follow the A361 until you reach the roundabout before Barnstaple. Then take the A39 (signed Bideford, Bude) past Bideford, Clovelly and Kilkhampton. Close to Bude look for a turning on the left signed Holsworthy/A3079 but stay on the A39. Shortly afterwards there is a roundabout. DO NOT follow the signs to Bude but continue South (1st exit) for about 3 miles. Budemeadows is signposted from the main road at the top of the rise just after the sign on the right for Widemouth Bay. Pull into the lay-by on the left and the site entrance is on the left.

The shortest route:



Remain on the M5 until past Exeter services. Exit at junction 31 to the A30 (signed Okehampton). Exit the A30 at Okehampton and go through the town. After climbing a long hill take the right turn (A3079), it is signed Bude, Holsworthy. Avoid Holsworthy town by turning right on the A3072, signed Bude. Go straight across mini roundabout, turn right on the A3072 (signed Bude). When meeting the A39 at Stratton turn left. At the roundabout DO NOT follow the signs to Bude but continue South (1st exit) for about 3 miles. Budemeadows is signposted from the main road, at the top of the rise just after the sign on the right for Widemouth Bay. Pull into the lay-by on the left and the site entrance is on the left.

Longer route, but better roads:



Remain on the M5 past Exeter services. Exit at junction 31 to the A30 (signed Okehampton). Stay on the A30 until approximately 5 miles past the first Launceston exit (ignoring all earlier signs for Bude) and take the exit signed "A395 North Cornwall, Camelford, Wadebridge". Turn right at first roundabout, cross flyover, turn left at second roundabout and follow North Cornwall/A395 signs (watch out for the windmills). At Hallworthy take the second turn right (signed Bude). At Give Way sign turn right onto A39 and stay on the A39 (going North) for approximately 12 miles. After Poundstock watch out for "Budemeadows" sign on main road, shortly after sign to Widemouth Bay on the left. Pull into lay-by on right. The site entrance is at the other end of the lay-by on the right.

Arrival Information

Pitches are available from 2:00PM and in High Season we are unable to accept arrivals before this time. Latest arrival time is 10:00 PM and we would ask you to inform us if you expect to arrive after 7:00 PM.

There are no spare parking spaces available on site but there is a limited amount of parking available in the lay-by outside the site. The main car parks in Bude do not have height restrictions and will accept car and trailer/caravan (although you do have to pay for 2 spaces).

On arrival please use the left hand lane, pull up to the barrier (or join the queue at busy times) and proceed on foot to reception to sign in.



Tractor Factors (when planning journey times you need to factor in the chances of getting stuck behind a tractor)



Mainly Motorway, dual carriageway and good quality roads



More country roads, some tight bends and steep hills.



Mostly single carriageway from Tiverton with sharp bends and high hedgerows beyond Barnstaple.
